


Why worry about freezing fuel as the temperature plunges?

As temperatures fall, diesel and Gasoil [red] turns cloudy and starts to form wax crystals. When the cold reaches -5 for prolonged periods of time, then the crystals grow and sink to the bottom of the tank. Eventually, the wax gets drawn through the supply lines and eventually begin to 'plug' the filters. This will prevent starting or even cause operational failure and therefore has potential safety implications.
